Wait, no--that last figure needs context. While TriSmart's base rate looks attractive, their financing APR averages 7.9% versus the Texas median of 5.4%. Always cross-check review claims with the Texas Comptroller's solar incentive database.

### The Underdog Innovators

Ever heard of bifacial panels that generate power from both sides? Dallas startup SolarEdge TX has been

installing these game-changers since 2022, boosting output by 15% compared to standard setups. Yet most solar company reviews don't mention this tech--it's buried in technical forums.

## Reading Between the Review Lines

Five-star ratings can lie. Here's what to hunt for:

Cluster reviews within 90 days (indicates current service quality)

Photos of installed conduit work

Mentions of HOA negotiation support

A Houston couple's viral TikTok review exposed how Premier Solar pressured them into oversizing their system. "They kept saying 'Go big or freeze next blackout,'" recalled homeowner Mia Rodriguez. Turns out, their 12kW system only needed 8kW--a \$14,000 upsell.

## Your Burning Questions Answered

Q: Do Texas solar companies honor price matching?

A: Only 23% do, per SolarReviews --always get it in writing.

Q: How important are BBB ratings versus Google reviews?

A: The Better Business Bureau resolves 90% of complaints, while Google lacks mediation. Check both.

Q: What's the real payoff period with current interest rates?

A: Most Texas homes break even in 6-8 years now versus 4-5 pre-2022.
