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The U.S. aftermarket's jumping on board too. Florida-based Circuit Soul sold 340 units last month, mostly to S13 owners chasing that authentic Initial D feel. Just remember - this isn't some plug-and-play mod. You'll need:

- Torque wrench (35-45 ft-lbs range)
- Steering angle calibration tool
- Patience (lots of it)

Global Market Trends in Steering Upgrades

Germany's T?V certification process has actually slowed adoption in Europe - only 12% of modified Nissans pass inspection on first try. Meanwhile, Australia's seeing 200% year-over-year growth in steering upgrades, thanks to relaxed import laws on JDM parts.
